

Question 2. My child feels safe at Herrick Primary School









Question 5. Herrick Primary School makes me aware of what my child is learning

















- More feedback during the term on how my child is progressing would be appreciated. As would provision for music and language lessons. Would be nice if reception staff would acknowledge receipt of emails they are sent.
- I would prefer teachers give home work to do in their hand instead of DB primary and all meetings face to face.
- No communication between parents and teachers this year apart from one parents evening often has different teachers
- Please give extra learning for home

- I feel the curriculum is dated and should include topics which would give the children a good understanding of how to survive in the world as well as what they are currently leaning.
- Absolutely fantastic education and personal development, provided in a safe and stable environment that also takes into consideration the child's needs, so they can progress to their best potential.
- "Please try to provide more places or more days to include all kids for afternoon clubs such as multiple sports so everyone can be in that club without disappointment. Please try to arrange more days or more tutors my child was so happy attending afternoon spots club."
- The teachers need to update parents on what they are learning and child's progress more often. Waiting for parents evening to raise any concerns or find out what they need to improve on isn't ideal for parent and teacher. It would be amazing if we could have a timetable of what is being taught in each term in each subject so that is parents can better prepare the children.

- I would like more feedback and communications especially regarding academics and what i
 can do to improve on my child's academics as i have experienced that in other schools within
 the same Leicestershire county. So far that has not been provided.
- I would like more feedback and communications regarding the SATs. I am yet to get requested information on this and well as follow up from the school in that regards. As a parent whose child is about to do the SATs in a couple of months and in unfamiliar terrain, i believe that adequate information has not been provided.
