



Homework Policy - KS1/KS2

Review: September 2027

Spellings

Termly spelling lists will be handed out at the start of each term. Each week, children will be tested upon a selection of spellings from these lists.

Reading Books

In term 1, KS1 children will be given one book on a weekly basis and in term 2, KS1 children will have the opportunity to independently choose and change their book.

KS2 children will have the option to change one book daily (fiction/non-fiction) if they return the previous book. Children are encouraged to read at home for at least 20 minutes daily.

Times Tables

In years 2 - 6 children have been provided with login details for TT Rockstars to practise their times tables. We recommend about 15 minutes daily. Children have been shown how to use TT Rockstars.

English / Maths Tasks

Each week, teachers will set homework tasks which focus upon:

- Reading Comprehension and/or Grammar and Punctuation
- Mathematics

This homework is emailed out to parents/carers on a Friday and is due back in school the following Wednesday.

Children have been provided with an exercise book to complete this homework in.

To enable parents/carers to support their children, and to ensure that children are given the opportunity to self-assess and have instant feedback, answers are sent out along with the homework.

Some children may also be set additional tasks to support skills such as handwriting, etc.

Curriculum Projects or Competitions

At times, in addition to the tasks mentioned above, children may also be set homework projects to complete.

On these occasions, the class teacher will provide the children with clear instructions explaining the expectations for the project that has been set.
